Guest lectures by international faculties are also arranged regularly to broaden the outlook of the students. In order to inculcate the spirit of teamwork and improve their leadership skills students have to be a member of at least one committee like Institute Social Responsibility (ISR), Corporate Interface Team (CIT), E-Cell, Public Relations, Equity Research, Co-Curricular, Sports, Alumni and Placement to name a few. Students are also encouraged to participate in various extracurricular activities, Institute Social Responsibilities (ISR) activities, cultural and sports events to develop personality and grow personally and professionally. Mock Group Discussions – Personal Interviews are arranged for the students which are conducted by industry experts. Special sessions on Interview and Soft Skills are also arranged. 
