1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Prospectus for admission to the UG/PG **Degree Programmes Under Choice Based Credit and Semester system** in the University Teaching Departments/Centres for the Academic year 2023-24, as approved vide U.O. No. **SWC/SWC/3676/2023** dated 24/03/2023, is published. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to the **UG/PG Programmes** in the University Teaching Departments/Centres.
- 1.2. Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University for the UG/PG Programmes (except those specifically mentioned) are purely based on the **Entrance Test**. Admission for MBA Programme is on the basis of the scores of KMAT/CAT/CMAT, Group Discussion & Interview. Admission for Integrated M.Com Programme shall be based on the entrance examination (60% weightage) and index marks (40% weightage) calculated as per existing rules followed for admission to B.Com. programme. All the eligible applicants have to appear for a written entrance test.
- 1.3. The prospectus issued by the University during the previous years for admission to **Post Graduate Degree Programmes** is not valid for the year 2023-2024. The prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the University.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

Admission to the UG/PG Degree Programmes in the University Teaching Departments/Centres will be made on the basis of **Online Centralized Allotment**. B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. and M.Ed. Programmes are not included in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP). The candidates who wish to apply for these Programmes shall apply directly to the Department concerned as and when the university invites applications.

Any candidate who desires to obtain admission for UG/PG Programmes in the Teaching Departments and Centres of Kannur University should compulsorily register through online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General /SEBC/ EWS/ SC/ST/ Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/Jammu and Kashmir/Persons With Disabilities/ Sports etc.) to which they belong.

Admission to the various Programmes in the Teaching Departments/Centres will be strictly following the rules and regulations regarding reservation.

3. PROGRAMMES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS AVAILABLE

- 3.1 **Details of the Programmes and Duration:** PG Programmes extend for a period of four semesters including MCA. Duration of B.A.L.L.B & Integrated M.Com programmes are 5 years (10 semesters) and the duration of LL.B. programme is 3 years (6 semesters). The Programme of study will be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means.

3.2 Programme Duration: PG Programmes shall be completed within the maximum period of 4 Years and the B.A.LL.B. programme shall be completed within 8 Years. For Integrated M.Com Programme, after completion of the first three years (SEM I to SEM VI), students would be awarded B. Com. degree if they wish to leave the programme with permission from University and after successful completion of five years, Integrated M.Com. Degree would be awarded.

3.3 Departments offering UG/PG Degree Programmes: The List of Teaching Departments/Centres of Kannur University and the subjects offered at each department and eligibility required are given in Annexure I of the Prospectus. **Generally, a Bachelor Degree (as detailed in Annexure I) of this university or any other Indian or Foreign University recognized by Kannur University as equivalent thereto is required for admission to PG Programme. Plus 2 after 10 years of schooling is required for admission to B.A.LL.B & Integrated M.Com programmes.**

3.4 Categorization of Seats: Seats available are mainly classified as Merit Seats and Reservation Seats

- a) **Merit Seats:** Seats that are filled by the University purely on the basis of marks obtained at entrance examination are classified as 'Merit Seats'.
- b) **Reservation Seats:** Seats which are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/EWS/PWBD/Transgender Persons/Sports persons are classified as 'Reservation Seats'.

4. RESERVATION OF SEATS

A candidate can claim only one benefit at a time as per his/her choice for a particular purpose.

4.1 Types of Reservation: Seats will be reserved for the following categories in each department for various UG/PG Degree Programmes.

- 1) Mandatory Reservation
- 2) Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability
- 3) Special Reservation and
- 4) Reservation for Nominees
- 5) Reservation for Transgender Persons

4.1.1 Mandatory Reservation

- EWS reservation of 10% shall be additionally created over and above the total strength of seats for all programmes.
- EWS reservation will be subject to orders issued by the Govt. from time to time.

* Candidates who enjoy Community Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST who have BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are **NOT** eligible for EWS reservation. Only the candidates belonging to Economically weaker section which does not belong to SC/ST or other backward classes as per reservation rule are eligible for EWS reservation. Such candidates shall produce either of the certificates from the Village Officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category”(Annexure V) or “The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category”(Annexure VI)

Note :

For obtaining SEBC reservation, Non Creamy Layer Certificate should be produced.

4.1.2 Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWBD):

- (i) 5% of the total seats, over and above the sanctioned strength will be set apart exclusively for persons with benchmark disabilities in each programme.

As per Clause 2(r), Chapter I of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, ‘Person with benchmark disability’ means a person suffering from not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates seeking admission under PWBD category should submit the ‘Certificate of Disability’ (permanent), by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the ‘Persons with Benchmark Disability’ category.

Note: The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se-merit list and physical suitability and not on the basis of the degree of disability.

No reservation of seat is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.

4.1.3 SPECIAL RESERVATION

Sports persons

One sports quota seat is reserved in all Teaching Departments over and above the sanctioned strength on the condition that the aspirants should qualify the entrance examination for the said course.

Criteria for sanctioning additional seats for outstanding sportspersons for UG/PG admission

- Additional seats shall be sanctioned within the statutory limit.
- The recommendation for the same from the concerned HOD shall be verified and recommended by the Director of Physical Education.
- The minimum achievement for additional seats shall be as per Sl. No. 20 of the Sports Quota

- Minimum achievements for UG admission under sports quota will be a place in the Revenue District competition (22 marks) and for PG course will be securing third place in the Inter Collegiate Sports Championship (30 marks) .
 - II and III positions are included as criteria for Sports Quota admissions in U.G. and P.G. courses.
1. Achievements in those sports disciplines approved by Association of Indian Universities only will be considered for Sports Quota Admissions.
 2. Priority shall be given while preparing rank list for those events in which Kannur University conducts inter collegiate competitions.
 3. Approved World Competitions means the Competitions organized by the International Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the national Teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline and in which the National teams are sponsored by the National Apex Bodies and cleared by Sports Authority of India/ Government of India.
 4. The National Championship means the Championships conducted by the National Apex Bodies of the concerned discipline. District Competition means revenue district competition conducted by district association in respective sports, regional competitions means competition organized by KV/Navodaya/CBSE in the regional basis.
 5. Games/ event means a game/ event in which individual performs alone.
 6. When a candidate has number of achievement in sports / different discipline his/ her best achievement will be taken into consideration.
 7. The sports achievements in last four years shall be considered for Sports Quota admissions of UG and PG courses for this academic year 2023-24.
 8. All competitions where an upper age limit is fixed (Youth/ Junior/ Sub-Junior) would be treated as junior event provided it is not classified as senior event by the concerned National Federation.

9. Priority will be given for students having achievements in senior level competitions.
10. When there is tie in the rank/mark the following criteria will be applied to break the tie:
 - (a) Priority will be given as per of their order of merit
i.e.; 1st, 2nd and 3rd place respectively.
 - (b) If the tie still remains those with a more number of achievements in the same level will be placed above the others. (more number of I places , more number of II places and so on.)
 - (c) If the tie still remains the next best achievement as per the order of merit will be considered
 - (d) If the tie is not broken by the above method the person having the achievements during the year closer to the selection will be given higher rank.
 - (e) Individual achievements will be ranked above team achievements.
 - (f) a new record is created, he/she will be given priority.
 - (g) If a tie cannot be broken by any of the above mentioned sports achievements, the marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for breaking the tie.

NOTE:

The Sports Quota candidates should also register through online before the closure of registration date. Students should submit printout of the application (along with copies of sports certificates) to the Director of Physical Education (Mangattupramba campus, Kannur University) along with a request to consider under sports quota. The Director of Physical Education will prepare a rank list as per the University norms. The rank list should be published in the Department notice board for students redressal for a minimum of three days for the final publication of the rank list.

If vacancies arise due to discontinuation of candidates under Sports quota, the next eligible candidate in the Rank List (Sports Quota) shall be admitted. In case there is no next eligible candidate, the vacant seat shall remain unfilled.

4.1.4 Reservation for Nominees

i) Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.

An additional seat shall be created for each PG Degree Programme (wherever necessary) in all departments, exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates.

ii) Concession for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley

The following relevant concessions are applicable for wards of Kashmiri migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission to the UG/PG courses in all departments

- Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.
- Increase in intake capacity up to 5% course wise.
- ☐ Waiving of domicile requirements for Kashmiri Migrants only. Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-migrants) living in the Kashmir valley need domicile certificate.

(iii) Reservation for Candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength to accommodate candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to PG courses in the Department for the

academic year 2023-24.

(iv) Reservation of seats for the widows /wards of Armed Forces of Personnel, killed/disabled in action during peace time.

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows /wards of Armed Forces Personnel, killed or disabled in action during peace time, in Central /State Universities /Autonomous/ Professional / Non-Professional Institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resource Development as per UGC policy. (Applicable to Army/Navy/Airforce only. Not applicable to paramilitary forces/CAPF/GREF/Coast Guard etc.)

4.1.5 Reservation for Transgender Persons

Two seats shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength in all courses in the University exclusively for admitting Transgender students. (G.O.(Ms)No.153/2018 HEdn dated 03.07.2018). Such candidates should submit transgender identity card issued by the State Government at the time of admission.

There will not be any upper /lower age limit for Transgender candidates for admission to any of the programmes in the University (G.O. (Ms.) No. 295/2021/HEDN dated 05/07/2021).

5. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED

- (i) Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should mention their claim in the **relevant columns** in the Personal and Academic Data Sheet. They should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the Prospectus, at the time of Online registration.
- (ii) Candidates should produce all original documents to prove their claims made in the online application form, at the time of admission. **The claims that are not mentioned at the time of online submission of application will not be entertained even if supporting evidences are produced later on. The claims for mandatory reservation, once made, cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.**

5.1.1 Claim for Community reservation under ‘Socially and Educationally Backward Classes’ (SEBC):

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

(a) As per G.O. (Ms) No.02/2017, Backward Community Development, dated 08/03/2017, candidates belong to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes under NON CREAMY LAYER category are eligible for reservation under this category. The candidates belonging to the Communities included in the SEBC list (as detailed in Annexure II(d)) alone will be eligible for the benefit of reservation under this category.

5.1.2 Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota

- (a) Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the caste/community certificate from the Village Officer/ Tahsildar.

(SC/ST list is given in Annexure II (a) & II (b))

Warning: Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for punishment as per rules.

(b) Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates (**OEC list is given in Annexure II(c)**) who claim allotment to the un-availed seats, under SC/ST quota, if any, should furnish community and non creamy layer certificate obtained from the Village Officer/Tahsildar.

Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category.

5.1.3 Claims for Reservation under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category

Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST are NOT eligible for EWS reservation. Only the candidates belonging to economically weaker section which does not belong to SC/ST or other backward classes as per reservation rule are eligible for EWS Reservation. Such candidates must produce either **of the certificates from the Village Officer namely “The applicant belonging to Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category”- (Annexure V) or “The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in General Category (Annexure VI).**

5.2 OTHER GENERAL RULES FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION

- 5.2.1 If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are remaining vacant such seats shall be filled up from the candidates belonging to OEC and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC. The seats that further remain unfilled will go to the open quota.
- 5.2.2 **Claim for fee concession to OEC candidates:** Candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities are exempted from payment of fee at the time of allotment to UG/PG Degree Programme irrespective of annual family income as per G.O (MS) No. 36/07/SCSTDD, dated: 03.07.2007. They should produce Community certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar at the time of admission.

List of Communities selected for OEC educational assistance is given in Annexure VII. They are eligible only for fee concession and not for OEC reservation.

6. RULES FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO VARIOUS UG/PG DEGREE PROGRAMME IN DEPARTMENTS

6.1. Weightage of marks for Scouts & Guides/Rovers & Rangers/SPC candidates (UG Programme)

The Weightage marks given to Scouts & Guides, Rovers & Rangers (who had won Rajyapuraskar Certificate/Nanmamudra Certificate) and SPC candidates, shall be 0.3% marks in addition to their index marks.

6.2. Weightage of marks for N.C.C. /N.S.S. Certificate holders (UG/PG Programme)

The weightage marks given to candidates holding NSS/NCC certificates shall be 0.3% marks in addition to their index marks.

The benefit of bonus marks for the purposes of admission can be earned by the candidates only under any one category of the above.

6.3 Equivalency/Recognition

Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from the universities outside Kerala after

regular study needn't produce equivalency certificate. Students who passed their degrees through Distance Education from universities outside Kerala (***except IGNOU Degrees that does not require hands on training***) and those who obtained regular degrees with different nomenclature should submit Equivalency Certificate (stating that the said degree of other University is equated to concerned degree of Kannur University) while seeking admission. If the eligibility is "any degree" recognition certificate is sufficient.

6.4. Candidates for PG Admission who passed their qualifying examination from other universities should submit application for recognition and remit required fee at the time of admission.

6.5. Candidates for UG/ PG Admission who passed their qualifying examination from other universities /Boards should submit application for matriculation and remit required fee at the time of admission.

6.6. Candidates who seek admission to UG course shall submit application for recognition and remit required fee at the time of Admission.

(Application Form for Recognition and Matriculation certificate available at university website and Fee prescribed in Annexure III)

6.7 Fee to be paid to the University

6.7.1 The Registration Fee will be as follows:

Fee for online registration for each programme: Rs. 500 /- for all candidates

other than SC/ST/PwBD candidates. Rs.200/- for SC/ST/PwBD candidates.

Note: Fee shall be remitted by SBI EPay only. The Registration Fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstance.

6.7.2 Fee to be paid at the time of admission:

Fee to be paid at the time of admission mentioned in Annexure III shall be remitted by **SBI EPay only**. (Please refer notification) .The details about **SBI EPay** can be had from the website www.kannuruniversity.ac.in.

6.8. Verification of Documents: The Head of the Department/Course Director /Asst Director shall be personally responsible for verification and satisfaction of the correctness of the documents/ records produced by the candidate, at the time of admission in the Departments/ Centres. The candidate should fulfill the eligibility criteria prescribed at the time of admission, in all respects, and all relevant documents shall be submitted at the respective Departments/Centres during the time of admission. The eligibility of the candidates for the course in all respects shall be confirmed by the Head of the Department/Course Director/Asst Director before the closing date of admission.

The HOD/Course Director/ Asst Director should ensure identification of the candidates and verify their photographs uploaded at the time of registration.

6.9. Documents to be produced in original at the time of admission:

- a. Print out of the completed online application generated by the candidate.
- b. Print out of registration fee & university fee remitted by the candidate by online.
- c. Original grade cards/mark lists and Provisional/Degree Certificate of the qualifying examinations.
- d. Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended and Course & Conduct Certificate.
- e. Original Community Certificate /**Anthyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority House Hold (PHH) category certificate (EWS) /The Income and Assets certificate for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)** if applicable
- f. Non creamy layer certificate in the case of SEBC candidates.
- g. Original certificates to prove the claim for grace marks, if any.
- h. Equivalency certificate(stating that the said degree of other University is equated to concerned degree of Kannur University) from the Kannur University in case of

candidates (for PG Admission) who have passed qualifying examination through Distance Education from Universities outside Kerala (*except IGNOU Degrees that does not require hands on training*) or has obtained degrees with different nomenclature.(Recognition certificate is sufficient if the eligibility is" any UG degree")

- i. Recognition certificate from the Kannur University in the case of candidates (for UG Admission) who have passed their qualifying examination from other Boards/Institutes/governments, except BOARD OF HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION Kerala, VHSE Kerala, THSE Kerala, CBSE and CISCE,NIOS,Kerala Literacy Mission,State/Central equivalent.
- j. Students and their parent/guardian should sign an affidavit at the time of admission as a part of anti-dowry campaign, in the given format (Annexure VIII & IX).
- k. Any other relevant certificate for any claim made in the application

6.10. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Failure to report for Admission: Candidates who do not take admission on the prescribed date will lose their admission.

2. Candidates have the freedom to change their password. However they should take note of the password and application number carefully, for future login.

3 Application of candidates who do not register their personal and academic data online and who do not give their options online within the time schedule will not be considered for admission. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any detail after the last date of submission of application. Late or defective application will not be considered under any circumstance.

4 Any kind of false information will lead to cancellation of admission.

5. No rounding of marks/percentage to the nearest whole number will be permitted.

6. Those who are awaiting results of the last semester/year, but passed in all the previous semesters/year can also apply. However, they have to submit the copies of the Marklist/Grade Card/Provisional Certificate to the Head of the Department/Asst Director/Course Director as the case may be, on or before the closing date of admission.

7. Do not send hardcopies of the printout of the online application to the university. The hard copy of the online application with supporting documents should be kept by the candidate and it has to be submitted at the time of admission to the respective department/centre.

8 Any other item which is not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the University and that decision will be final.

9. Preventive measures against ragging: if an applicant for admission is found to have been indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she had indulged in ragging, admission will be revoked or he/she will be expelled from the educational institution. 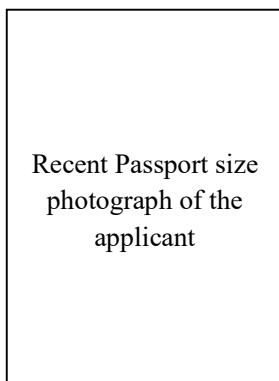

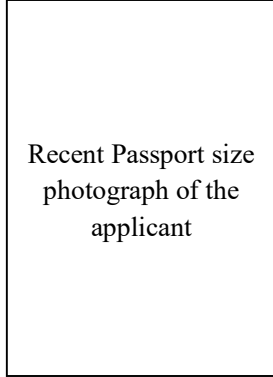
