MBA (FULL-TIME) PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The two-year full-time MBA program at FMS Delhi aims to develop highly skilled professional managers capable of excelling across industries while promoting thought leadership and societal welfare. The curriculum is built on two pillars: a strong analytical foundation in key business functions and high academic flexibility, allowing students to tailor their MBA experience.

In the first year, students gain essential business knowledge through rigorous training and conclude with a Summer Internship to apply management concepts in real-world settings. The second year focuses on professional development, with students refining their learning through electives and interactions with industry leaders. A student must complete 32 courses during the course of this programme.

The annual fees is currently Rs. 5,00,000/- (*USD 5800) for MBA Full-Time programme for SAARC countries(except Tibet). The same for students enrolling in MBA Full-Time for Non-SAARC countries is Rs. 8,00,000/-(*USD 9230) Additionally, a charge of Rs 1,01,640 (*USD 1170)will cover both one-time and annual charges.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & GUIDELINES FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreign nationals seeking admission to the MBA (FT) program in FMS, Delhi University should have already passed in their qualifying degree program and must submit their qualifying degree final results with the application. Students pursuing their qualifying degree or waiting for results are not eligible to apply.

Candidates must have a minimum score of 650 in GMAT or 120 in GRE to apply for the admission to the MBA (FT) program at FMS

Students who are recipients/ awardees of study scholarship from either ICCR (Government of India) or Government of the applicant's country are exempt from the GMAT or the GRE eligibility.


The candidate must submit a certificate that the medium of instruction for their qualifying degree in English from his/her institution.

The number of the FSR seats (out of the Total 25) would be divided as follows: SAARC region (8); Other countries (17). There will be no transfer of seats from one category region to other regions


the selection During process, weightages will be assigned by various academic components which shall be announced by the FMS before the admission process begins.


